SUMMER READING WITH OUR LIBRARY AMBASSADORS

The Library uses BEANSTACK, an online reading program and recommendation service that patrons may use to record their reading. The service may be used alone or in conjunction with the Summer Reading paper logs. See how to create an account above.

Husband Matt agrees, "We don't need a lot of extra motivation to read, but winning free books is nice, and it's fun to get rewarded for something we're doing anyway."
