Some of our youngest patrons, ages 3 – 10, may now enjoy a NEW DIGITAL SERVICE designed to help build literacy and the love of learning through reading.

BOOKFLIX is an award-winning service that introduces children to engaging, animated storybooks, that are then paired with related nonfiction eBooks that are designed to spark educational discoveries. Offered through Scholastic, this service is now available on **several computers in the children's section of the Library**.

Preschool – **elementary students** may drop by the Library to enjoy one of the **125 pairs of videos and eBooks** available on a wide range of topics, including animals, nature, planets, ABCs, music & celebrations.

Children using this database will have the opportunity to listen or read along with wellknown actors and entertainers. The books and topics were carefully chosen and were created to promote early literacy skills such as comprehension and vocabulary, in addition to sharing real world knowledge. Learning another language is also encouraged with **35 pairs of eBooks in Spanish**. Other features include author biographies and games, and activities that test comprehension and reinforce vocabulary. Parents may also access parent tips and resources that help further their children's learning.


