The Library is excited to offer two new gadgets for check out: LAUNCHPADS and MOBILE WI-FI HOTSPOTS!

DESIGNED FOR CHILDREN, LAUNCHPAD TABLETS are preloaded with themed educational games and activities, from STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art & math), to dinosaurs, music, animals, and more!

Drop by the Library's Youth Dept. to find Launchpads loaded with appropriate content for youth ages 3 - 5 and ages 5 - 7.



LAUNCH PAD FACTS:

Available for a 3-week check-out with one automatic renewal (renewal may be prevented if a hold is on item). Earphones are not required for audio playback. These devices do not have Internet connectivity. Includes usage statistics for parents.

READY, SET, GO check out a COOLPAD SURF MOBILE HOTSPOT and take convenient, portable internet access with you while you vacation, staycation, or

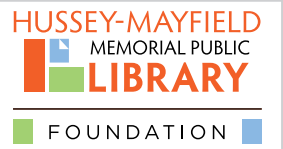
